Section 1: Dressage and Jumping – (classes 1- 4 novice/inexperienced combinations)

Class 1	8 yrs & under lead rein	D Test 2012	Jumps very small
Class 2	8 yrs & under (assisted)	D Test 2012	Jumps not over 45cm
Class 3/4	Beginners (please put age as class will be split if enough entries)	Introductory Test 2007	Jumps not over 55cm
Class 5	Junior (under 14 on 1 st Jan 13)	Novice Eventing Test 2013	Jumps not over 75cm
Class 6	Novice	Novice Eventing Test 2013	Jumps not over 90cm
Class 7	Inter	Int Eventing Test 2009	Jumps not over 105cm
Class 8	Open	Open Eventing Test 2010	Jumps not over 110cm

Section 2: Dressage Only

Class 9	Junior (under 14 on 1 st Jan 13)	Introductory Test 2007
Class 10	Novice	Novice Dressage 2009
Class 11	Intermediate	Intermediate Dressage 2013
Class 12	Open Area	PC Open Dressage Test 2008

Classes will not run in class order. We have 4 dressage arenas and 2 SJ arenas.

Section 3: Show Jumping Only (Classes 13, 14, 15, 16 will be in ring 2 after classes 4-1 (approx. 12 noon), classes 17-21 will start after classes 5-8 in ring 1 approx 2pm)

Class 13 Lead Rein	Jumps very small (rider may not enter class 15 and above)
Class 14 ponies only -assistance permitted	50cm (LR riders may not enter class 15 and above)
Class 15	60cm
Class 16	70cm
Class 17	70/75cm (Area Junior 1 st round height)
Class 18	85/90cm (Area Novice 1 st round height)
Class 19	100cm (Area Int 1 st round height)
Class 20	110cm (Area open 1 st round height)

All classes will run as a 2 phase – Classes 17-20 carry on if clear over rest of course. Jump off will be up to 5/10cm bigger (class 20 will only run with 4 + competitors) BS Area jumps.
Classes 13-16 shortened course against the clock. Jumps same height at first round.- PC jumps.

P(UK) Burghley Event Pony; Pony Club invitational – this is not running this year. P(UK) have cancelled it due to lack of sponsorship at their end. If they find sponsorship we will beginning again in 2014.

Section 4: Handy Hunter - will be open from 100pm-300pm. Prize giving for all HH classes at SJ ring 2 at 330pm approx.

Class 21	8 and under LR/assisted .
Class 22	10 years and under off lead rein
Class 23	11 years and over

Directions to Jenkinsons field: From Carlton Roundabout follow signs to Shap A6, Through Eamont Bridge. After passing Lowther Caravan Park gates (on right) take the 2nd road to the left.

RULES

- * If a competitor starts on the Lead rein they must stay on the lead rein all day. Class 1, 13, and 21 are the only lead rein. LR riders may enter class 14 but must be off LR but can be assisted.
- * If you enter classes 1-4 you may not enter classes 5-8 competitively on the same horse/pony. You may do so HC and will not be eligible for prizes in classes 5-8,
- * Competitors may only enter once as a horse/rider combination Class 5-8. You may ride a different horse/pony in more than 1 class.
- * All classes run under Pony Club Dressage and Show Jumping Rules 2013.
- * Class 1 to 4 and class 9 can use any normal riding bit in the dressage.
- * Only classes 1 to 4 may have a commander for the dressage. All others must be ridden from memory (run under Area competition rules)
- * If you have represented your branch at Area level in SJ or Eventing you may not enter classes 3/4 on the pony you rode on the Area team.
- * If you wish to be considered for the SJ/Dressage/Eventing teams it is advisable to jump the team height for your chosen area selection and do at least 1 of the dressage tests that will be used. Juniors should enter class 5 (not class 3/4 on the team pony, and SJ classes 16 and above)
- * Whips can only be carried in classes 1- 4 & 9-12, of any length. No whips in eventing tests 5-8.
- * Class 3/4 and 9 will be judged by a different Judge.
- * Hats must be worn at all times. PC Members must abide by PC hat rule (11) and hats need to be tagged.
- * All dressage tests up to 2013 are available on the pony club web site www.pcuk.org
- * Trophy to winning combination (or highest placed CFHS member) in each of the classes 1-12.
- * The PC has agreed that nickel bits and irons are unsafe.
- * Ponies/horses must be tacked up properly and riders appropriately dressed for all classes at all times.
- * **PLEASE MAKE SURE ON THE DAY YOU PRESENT TO THE DRESSAGE ARENA 10MINS BEFORE YOUR TIME OR YOU WILL BE ELIMINATED**
- * Medial cover at our events complies with PC rules
- * We reserve the right to refuse entries from those we feel are over qualified/or entered the wrong class.
- * Maximum height of jumps in practice ring will be no higher than the class being jumped.
- * **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT ENCLOSED**
- * **At all our events objections must be accompanied by a deposit of £10 that will be refunded if the objection is upheld within 30 mins of the class finishing. Results will be posted for 30mins before any prizegiving.**

BY SIGNING THE DECLARATION ON ALL ENTRY FORMS YOU ARE GUARANTEEING THAT YOU HAVE APPROPRIATE THIRD PARTY INSURANCE. UNSIGNED DECLARATIONS WILL BE RETURNED.

For Pony Club Members a hat **with the BSI kitemark** and either BSEN 1384:1997 or EN 1384:1996 or PAS 015:1998 must be worn when mounted and the chin strap must be fastened. Also Snell E2001 with the official Snell label and number or AS/NS 3838 1998 or AS/NS 38382003 with the official SAI Global label. **These standards are compulsory for Pony Club members at all our events and random checks may be made.**
