Age as of 1st January Pick-A-Fence Competition

Class 1	Riders 8 – 9 yrs	fences from 1'6" – 2'4"	(C option)
Class 2	Riders 10 – 11 yrs	fences up to 2'9"	(B & C options)
Class 3	Riders 12 – 13 yrs	fences up to 3'6"	(A, B & C options)
Class 4	Riders 14 – 15 yrs	fences up to 3'6"	(A, B & C options)
Class 5	Riders 16 yrs & over	fences up to 3'6"	(A, B & C options)
Class 6	Riders 16 yrs & over (Novice)	fences up to 2'9"	(B & C options)

(Restricted to a combination of Horse & Rider that have never previously been placed 1st to 3rd in any competition involving jumping)

Entry Fee: £18.00 (to include Paramedic Cover)

(Entries Close Monday 18th October 2010)

Pallinsburn is situated on the A697 approximately 8 miles north of Wooler
and 4 miles south of Cornhill-on-Tweed

Rules

- Ø A horse/pony may only compete in one Pick-a-Fence class.
- Ø Non Pony Club Members are strongly recommended to have their own insurance.
- Ø Hats to the following standards must be worn whilst mounted: BS PAS 015 1998, BS EN 1384 1997, EN 1384 1997, SEI Snell E95, BS ASTM 1163 95, SEI ASTM 95 or SNZ 3838 1998.
- Ø Body Protectors and Medical Armbands are compulsory for Cross Country.
- Ø No stopwatches to be worn.
- Ø No dogs allowed on the course.
- Ø Objections may be lodged within 5 minutes of results being given but a £10 deposit must be lodged with the organising committee whose decision is final.

Disclaimer of Liability: Neither the organisers nor the North Northumberland Hunt Pony Club accept liability for any accident, damage, illness or injury to horses, riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.

Pick-a-Fence Scoring:

- Ø Riders may attempt the highest fence option for their class. If they clear that successfully they proceed to the next fence. If they stop, they may then attempt the next available height. If they stop again, then the lowest option may be attempted and the competitor will receive the points for that element. If they fail to negotiate an obstacle, they may continue to the next fence but will score no points.
- Ø Junior & Novice riders may only jump the option on their marked course, not a higher option.
- Ø Riders must give way to horses which catch up with them on the course but may then proceed at a safe distance. Jump judges are authorised to eliminate riders who do not maintain a safe distance between themselves and the preceding horse.

Rosettes: 1st to 6th in each class.

In the event of cancellation £5 per competitor will be retained to cover costs.

Catering and Toilets will be available on the field.

The course will be open for inspection on Saturday 23rd October 2010 from 2.00 pm.

Times will be posted on the Secretary's caravan or will be available on Thursday 21st October 2010 by telephoning 01890 820750 between 6.00 pm and 9.00 pm.
