## General Rules

- The competition will be run according to the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2013. The secretary will have a copy.
- Elimination on the XC means you must stop and walk home.
- If eliminated in the SJ you will be able to start XC.
- No horse may compete in more than one class.
- No competitor may ride more than two horses in one class.
- As this is a Pony Club Event, only PC members will be eligible for trophies. Therefore the highest placed PC member in each class will receive the trophy.
- **Medical Armbands are compulsory for all cross country phases.**
- **For Cross Country riding (including tests & training) over fences 0.80m high & above; a jockey skull cap with NO fixed peak must be worn. It is also strongly recommended that a jockey skull cap is worn for cross country riding over lower fences.**

**PAS 015:1998 / BSEN1384:1997 / EN1384:1996**

- **An effective body protector must be worn.**
- Any competitor reporting late risks elimination.
- A veterinary surgeon will be on call but all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the competitor.
- The organising committee, the NNH branch of the Pony Club and the owners of the venue, Mr & Mrs G Farr, do not accept any liability for any accident, damage or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
- Protests or objections must be made to the secretary in writing with a deposit of £10 within half an hour of the incident or of the scores being published, or within 1 hour of the publication of dressage scores.
- In the event of cancellation a full refund will be given.
- The course may be walked after 2pm on Saturday 15th June. Times will be listed on the secretary's caravan. For anyone not able to walk the course times can be obtained on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June between 8.30pm and 9.30pm from:
