

## General Rules

1. Rider's Age to be taken from 21st August 2011. Each competitor may take part in one age group only.
2. When mounted, correctly fitting hard hats to Standard PAS 015, BS EN 1384, SNELL E2001 or AS/NZ53838 must be worn. Body protectors are recommended.
3. The Yetholm Gymkhana Committee do not accept any liability for accident, damage or injury to horse owner, rider, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever. Riders and all others are advised to have their own insurance.
4. A Shield and rosette will be awarded to the overall winner of each age group with a reserve champion rosette as well.
5. Rosettes will be awarded 1st to 6th in every class, as well as prize money, 1st £2 , 2nd £1 and 3rd 50p .
6. There will be an overall Working Hunter Championship with the first two going forward from each class for "The Dolly Mixture Trophy".
7. Equitation Class. To be judged on the partnership and turnout of horse/pony and rider. To do a short show and no jumping. (There will be a set show for everyone and a leaflet can be picked up when your number is collected). There will be an overall championship for this class with the first two going forward from each class.
8. Clear round. Entry on day. The ring will be open to everyone all day. The size of jumps will vary with a notice by the side of ring at what height the jumps will be at what time. £2 for first round there after a £1. Only one rosette will be given.
9. The Barrel Challenge. Entry on day. This class will be open all day to everyone. 1st to 6th will be awarded in each age group with the fastest overall receiving "The Kippie Knowe Challenge Trophy". £2 for the first round there after a £1. (you can have as many goes as you want). Points will be awarded for this for the overall championship. Only your fastest time will count for a rosette.
10. There will be a trophy for the Best Racehorse (points in the events of the day), and also rosettes given out 1st to 3rd in each competition for the over 16's. Please note Racehorses do not need to be retired and do not need to be a member of any of the associations. For "The Mossy Moore Trophy"
11. In the event of a tie for points for an Overall Championship, it will be awarded to highest placing in the Handy Pony then Show Jumping. In a tie in the games the highest placing in bending will count.
12. If there are too many entries in a class it may be split.
13. Any complaints can be lodged with a £20 deposit. Refundable if you are correct.
14. Refreshments available.
15. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.
